STEPHENMINISTRY

Stephen Ministers are well trained lay people who work with the pastoral staff in creating a CARE NETWORK for people who are hurting. Stephen Ministry training is a 50 hour program that educates and prepares a Stephen Minister to be a one-on-one Christ-centered care-giver to someone who is hurting. Each Stephen Minister is then paired with a hurting person—men with men, women with women—who then meet weekly to care, pray, and encourage. Stephen Ministers care for those dealing with grief, divorce, job change, hospitalization, financial struggles, loneliness, convalescence, terminal illness, and other life challenges.

Training will begin January 10th @ 6:30pm in Room 302.
